

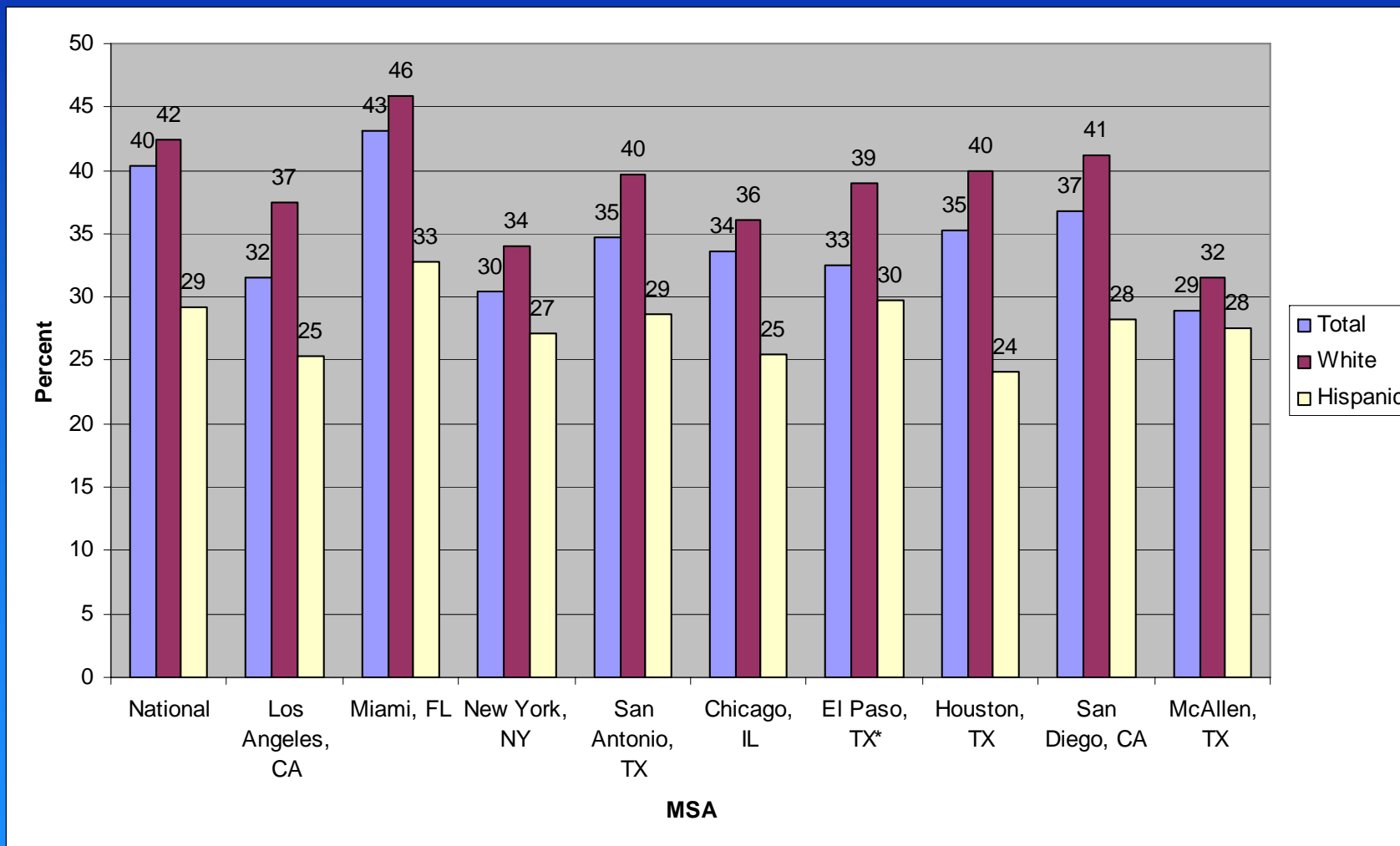


## **Examining Disparities Among Hispanic and non-Hispanic White Medicare Beneficiaries at the Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) Level**

  - **Los Angeles, Miami, New York, San Antonio, Chicago, El Paso, Houston, San Diego, and McAllen (TX)**
- **The four Hispanic and non-Hispanic White data sets included in the following tables comprise 2002 Medicare beneficiary data at the MSA level, illustrating:**
  - **Percentage of Medicare beneficiaries receiving mammograms**
  - **Percentage of Medicare beneficiaries receiving any type of colorectal screening**
  - **Percentage of Medicare beneficiaries diagnosed with diabetes**
  - **Percentage of Medicare beneficiaries diagnosed with diabetes and received eye-exams**

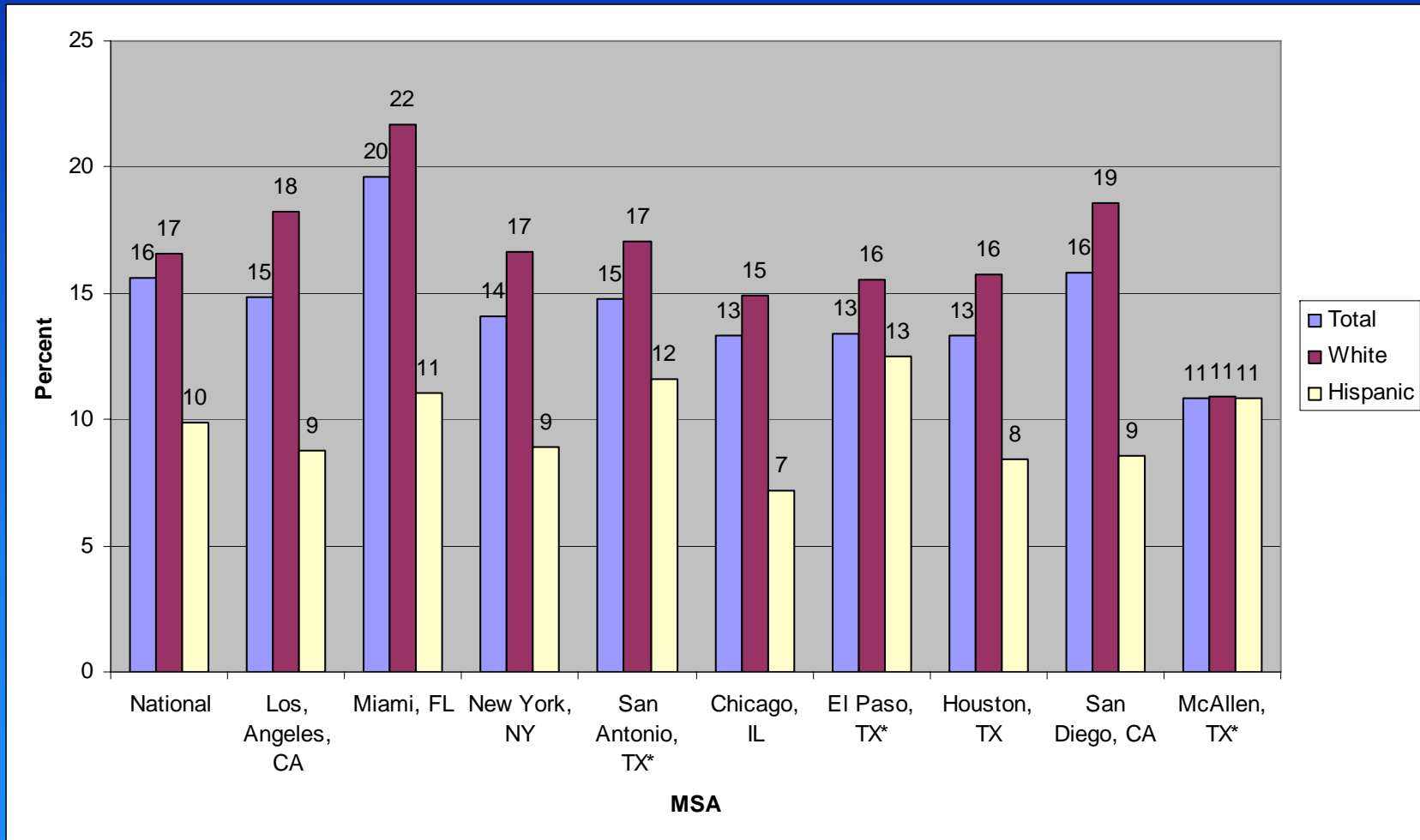


# Hispanic Medicare Beneficiary Disparities in Mammography by MSA, 2002





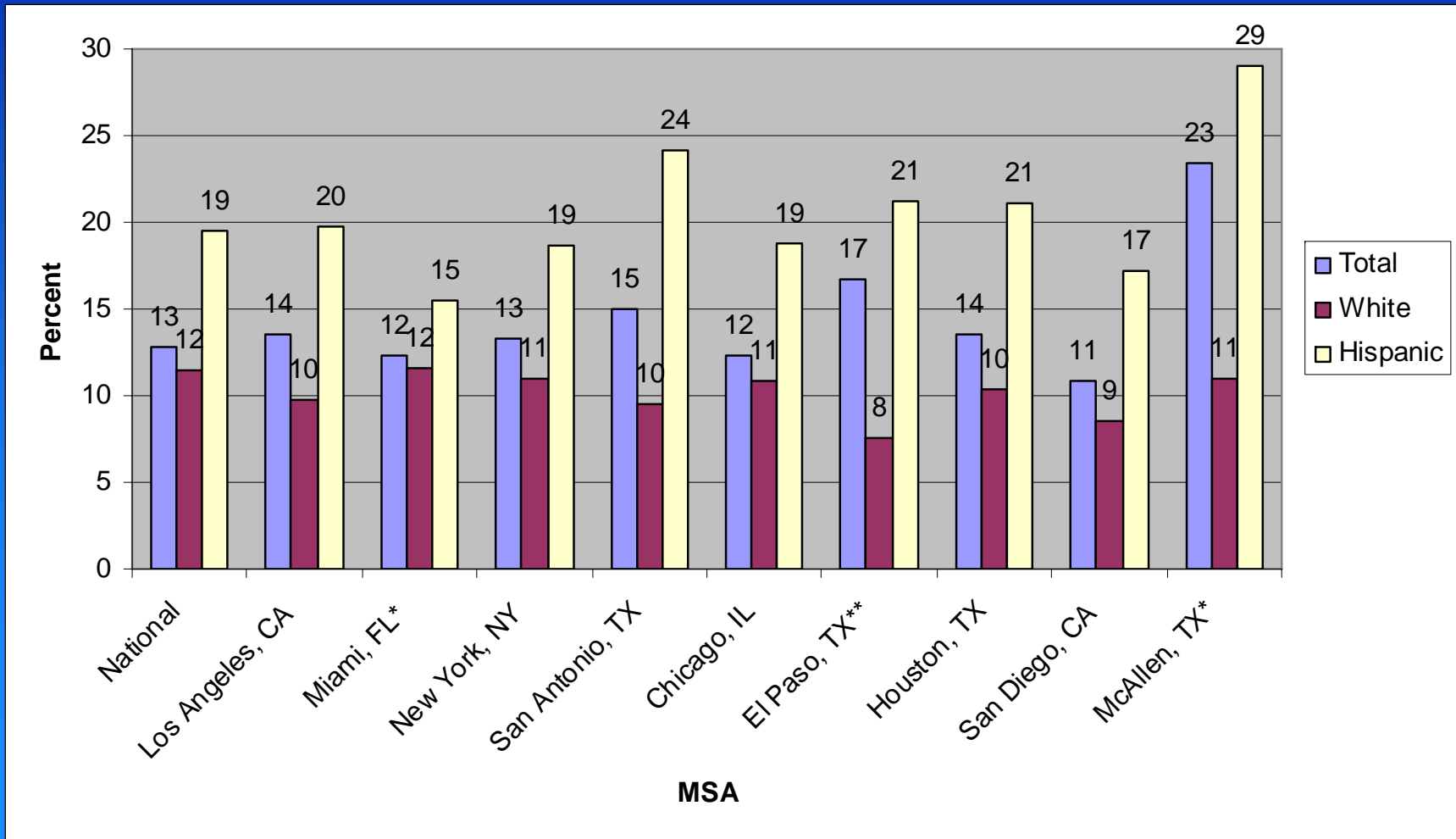
# Hispanic Medicare Beneficiary Disparities in Any Type of Colorectal Screenings\* by MSA, 2002
