
AcademyHealth's LTSS Mentorship Program

General guidelines and expectations:

- Meet at least twice a year
 - o Connect in person (e.g., at AcademyHealth's Annual Research Meeting) or online.
 - o First meeting: Introductions, identifying mentee needs, goal-setting
 - Second meeting: Progress check-in, additional guidance from the mentor
- Maintain open communication
 - Identify a communication method that works for both and maintain engagement
 - Set clear expectations on availability and follow-up meetings
